General King called for considerable special fire from the forward battalion, and it was reported that such fire was effective. At this time, the enemy had complete terrestrial observation of the terrain north of Forges woods. This observation was obtained from the high ground across the Meuse in the vicinity of Haraumont. The enemy also had direct observation of a good part of the CumieresForges road and the valley of Forges Brook. Hostile artillery fire was heavy on many of the roads such as the road west out of Gercourt and west out of Dannevoux. The town of Dannevoux was heavily shelled with gas. The right elements--Infantry elements--of the 33rd American Division were subjected to some front line artillery fire of the enemy, but not as much as were the left elements, that is General Kings Brigade.
