The Naval Academy cannot attach too much importance to the physical development of its midshipmen. For these reasons the Board regrets to learn that the appropriation for the Academy provides for less than a third of the instructing staff in physical education deemed necessary by the Academic Board, and that a considerable part of the expense of carrying this essential part of the curriculum has to be provided from what are properly private funds supplied by the Athletic Association. The Board recommends to the Navy Department and to the Congress that adequate instruction in physical education be provided...
